

On-site cable tray installation requirements

Proper on-site cable tray installation ensures safe, organized, and maintainable electrical and communication cabling systems.

Planning and Preparation

Before any physical installation, review approved shop drawings to confirm tray routes, dimensions, mounting heights, support systems, and the number of layers required for different cable types . Check for potential clashes with other services such as HVAC ducts, fire protection pipes, and drainage systems, and coordinate with engineers to resolve conflicts . Ensure all materials, including trays, ladders, couplers, brackets, and grounding straps, are available, inspected for damage, and stored properly on a flat surface with timber supports to prevent moisture or sunlight damage .

Selecting Tray Type and Sizing

Choose the appropriate tray type based on load and environment: ladder trays for airflow and easy cable entry, perforated trays for lighter loads, and solid-bottom trays for sensitive or structured cabling . Calculate tray width and depth according to cable count, type, and spacing requirements to prevent overheating or wasted space . Maintain proper vertical separation between layers, typically at least 30 cm, to avoid interference between electrical and telecommunication signals .
