

On-site fabrication for cable tray installation



Summary of Content

On-site cable tray fabrication and installation involve careful planning, material preparation, support fabrication, assembly, and compliance with safety and engineering standards.

Planning and Material Preparation

Before starting on-site work, review the approved shop drawings to understand the layout, lengths, and locations of cable trays and ladders in the building . Inspect all received materials, including cable trays, ladders, fittings, and accessories, for damage or discrepancies, and remove unsuitable items from the site . Store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at one-meter intervals, protecting them from moisture and sunlight . Ensure all tools and equipment comply with contract requirements.

Fabrication of Support Structures

On-site fabrication typically involves mild steel (MS) support structures for galvanized iron (GI) cable trays. Wall-mounted supports are fabricated using MS angles (e.g., 50 x 50 mm, 6 mm thick) at intervals of approximately one meter . For longer spans, bridge supports can be fabricated using MS C-channels (e.g., 150 x 75 mm, 5.7 mm thick) welded to existing structures. All welded areas should be primed with red oxide and finished with enamel paint for corrosion protection .
