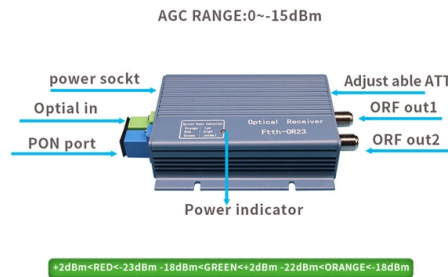


Opening a hole for a concealed electrical distribution box



Summary of Content

To install a concealed distribution box, reserve a wall hole slightly larger than the box dimensions, ensure proper depth, and follow safety and mounting standards.

Step 1: Determine Box Size and Location

Measure the length, width, and depth of the distribution box. The hole should be about 20mm larger than the box dimensions in length and width to allow for fitting and plastering, and the depth should accommodate the box plus the plaster layer on the wall surface (). Choose a dry, accessible location at a standard height (typically around 1.5 meters) for easy access and maintenance ().

Step 2: Mark and Prepare the Wall

- Use a pencil or marker to outline the hole on the wall.
- Ensure the box will be level and flush with the finished wall surface.
- Check for any existing wiring, plumbing, or structural elements behind the wall to avoid damage.

Step 3: Safety Precautions

- Turn off the circuit at the main breaker feeding the area.
- Verify power is off using a non-contact voltage tester.
- Wear safety glasses and gloves to protect against debris and sharp edges ().
