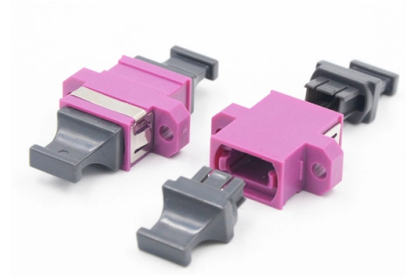


Opening a hole in the wall for the electrical distribution box



Summary of Content

To install an electrical distribution box, carefully measure, mark, and cut a hole using appropriate tools while following safety and code guidelines.

Safety First

Before starting, turn off the power at the circuit breaker and verify with a voltage tester that the area is de-energized . Wear safety goggles, gloves, and a dust mask to protect against debris and dust . Ensure the workspace is dry to prevent electrical hazards.

Planning and Measuring

- Determine the location of the box considering convenience, height, and local building codes .
- Use a stud finder to avoid cutting into studs or existing wiring .
- Mark the outline of the box on the wall with a pencil, ensuring it is level using a spirit level .

Cutting the Hole

- Drywall: Use a hole saw or drywall saw for round holes, or a combination of a round cutter and chisel for square holes . Start with a pilot hole to guide the saw or chisel .
- Masonry or concrete walls: Use an SDS drill with rotary/impact function and a masonry bit to create a pilot hole, then expand with a round cutter and square off with a chisel .
