Fiber Optic Cable Structure

At the core of an optical cable is the fiber core, an ultra-pure glass or plastic filament that carries light signals, typically 5–75 micrometers in diameter for multimode fibers. Surrounding the core is the cladding, a layer with a lower refractive index that ensures total internal reflection, keeping light confined within the core. Together, the core and cladding form the bare fiber. Additional layers provide mechanical protection, including buffer coatings, strength members, and outer jackets, which may include hybrid designs combining optical fibers with copper conductors for power delivery. Specialized cables like OPGW integrate fibers with aluminum and steel layers for high-voltage environments, serving both as data conduits and lightning protection.

Network Topology

Optical cable network diagrams map the flow of data from a central office (CO) to end users. The CO houses core switches and media converters that transform electrical signals into light pulses for long-distance transmission. Single-mode fibers are used for long-distance links between the CO and buildings due to their low signal loss, while multimode fibers distribute data within multi-unit buildings. In buildings, a central rack chassis manages incoming signals and distributes them to floors or offices, often using multimode fiber. Media converters at endpoints translate light signals back into copper-based signals for devices like laptops.
