Overview of Connection Methods

Optical distribution boxes (ODBs) serve as intermediate nodes in fiber networks, distributing fiber from feeder cables to multiple subscriber lines. The main connection methods include: 1. Fusion Splicing: The most common method, where the fiber cores from the incoming cable and pigtail are precisely aligned and fused using heat. This creates a low-loss, permanent connection. The spliced fibers are then stored in splice trays within the box to protect them from bending and mechanical stress . 2.

Mechanical Splicing: An alternative to fusion splicing, mechanical splicing aligns the fiber ends using a gel or mechanical fixture. This method is faster but generally has slightly higher insertion loss compared to fusion splicing . 3. Adapter and Connector Connections: ODBs often include adapters that allow plug-and-play connections with fiber patch cords. This method is used for flexible deployment, testing, or temporary connections. Common connectors include SC, LC, or FC types, which can be inserted or removed as needed . 4. Use of Optical Splitters: In FTTH or FTTB networks, optical splitters may be installed inside the distribution box to divide a single feeder fiber into multiple subscriber fibers. This allows one fiber to serve multiple endpoints efficiently . 5. Jumper-Free or Direct Connections: Some distribution boxes use a jumper-free design, where backbone fibers are directly spliced to distribution fibers without intermediate patch cords, reducing insertion points and potential signal loss .
