

Optical Splitter and Sub-routers



Summary of Content

An optical splitter can be directly connected to a sub-router, but in typical PON architectures, splitters primarily distribute optical signals to multiple ONTs rather than directly to routers.

Function of an Optical Splitter

An optical splitter is a passive device that divides a single incoming optical signal into multiple output signals without requiring power, using the physics of light to distribute signals efficiently. In FTTH networks, splitters allow a single fiber from the central office (CO) to serve multiple homes or devices, reducing the need for separate fibers for each endpoint. Splitters can also combine multiple signals into one, functioning bidirectionally for two-way communication.

Typical Network Architecture

In a standard PON setup, the optical line terminator (OLT) at the CO sends optical signals to the splitter, which then distributes the signals to multiple Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at the customer premises. The ONT converts optical signals to electrical signals, which are then connected to a home or sub-router for internet access. The splitter itself does not perform routing or packet processing; it simply replicates the optical signal to multiple outputs.
