2. Multimode Fiber (MMF) Multimode fibers have a larger core diameter, allowing multiple light modes to travel simultaneously. They are more cost-effective for short-distance applications, such as local area networks (LANs) and data centers. Multimode fibers are categorized into:
- OM1: 62.5 μm core, up to 300 meters at 10 Gbps.
