- **Check Fiber Connections:** Ensure the optical cable is securely connected to the ONT or switch port. Inspect for bends, cuts, or visible damage, and clean connectors with appropriate cleaning tools .
- **Power Cycle the Device:** Turn off the ONT or router, wait 30 seconds, and turn it back on to reset the module and re-establish the connection .
