Key Factors Affecting Optical Module Distance

1. Module Type (SR vs LR) Short-range (SR) modules are designed for distances up to about 300 meters using multimode fiber, which has a larger core and supports multiple light modes. Long-range (LR) modules can transmit up to 10 kilometers using single-mode fiber, which has a smaller core and supports a single light mode. Choosing the wrong module for the fiber type or distance can drastically reduce effective mileage . 2. Wavelength and Fiber Compatibility Different wavelengths (e.g., 850nm for SR, 1310nm for LR) interact differently with fiber types. Using a short-range wavelength on a long fiber or mismatching fiber types can cause signal degradation, unstable connections, or complete link failure . 3. Transmitter Power and Receiver Sensitivity The optical power output by the transmitter (TOSA) and the minimum detectable power by the receiver (ROSA) determine the link budget. Higher transmitter power and better receiver sensitivity allow longer distances. Conversely, lower power or poor sensitivity reduces effective mileage . 4. Environmental and Installation Factors Real-world conditions such as fiber bends, splices, connectors, and temperature variations can attenuate the signal. Even modules with identical datasheet specifications may perform differently depending on installation quality and environmental factors . 5. Data Rate and Signal Modulation Higher data rates require stronger signals and more precise detection. As the rate increases, receiver sensitivity typically worsens, reducing the maximum achievable distance .
