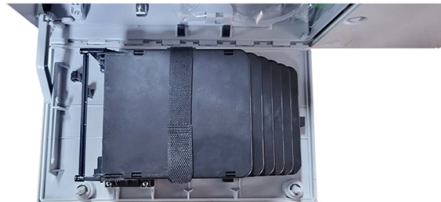


Optical module output level
