A single module optical port is a compact, hot-pluggable interface on network devices that connects a single fiber optic transceiver, typically supporting single-mode or multi-mode fiber for data transmission.

Overview

A single module optical port is designed to accommodate a Small Form-factor Pluggable (SFP) transceiver, which converts electrical signals from network equipment into optical signals for fiber optic transmission and vice versa . These ports are widely used in switches, routers, firewalls, and optical line terminals, allowing flexible deployment of different fiber types and data rates without replacing the entire device .

Single-Mode vs Multi-Mode

- **Single-Mode (SM) Fiber:** Uses a small core to transmit light in a single straight path, ideal for long-distance communication with minimal signal loss. Single-mode SFP modules are often labeled with terms like "SM," "Long Haul," or standards such as G.652, and typically operate at wavelengths of 1310 nm or 1550 nm .
- **Multi-Mode (MM) Fiber:** Has a larger core allowing multiple light paths, suitable for short-distance applications like within data centers or campus networks. Multi-mode SFPs usually operate at 850 nm and are optimized for distances up to a few hundred meters .
