While fully compliant with MPO standards, MTP modules feature tighter mechanical tolerances, improved ferrule alignment, floating ferrules, and enhanced guide pins, resulting in lower insertion loss, higher durability, and better performance under frequent mating cycles . MTP modules are particularly suited for high-density, high-speed data center environments where optical performance and reliability are critical .
