Low-voltage switchgear is a centralized assembly of protective devices designed to safely control, isolate, and protect electrical circuits up to 1,000 volts.

Overview

Low-voltage (LV) switchgear is used to distribute electrical power safely and reliably in industrial, commercial, and utility applications. It typically handles voltages up to 1,000 V AC or 1,500 V DC and currents up to several thousand amperes, feeding motor control centers, switchboards, and branch circuits in critical processes such as manufacturing, mining, water treatment, datacenters, and healthcare facilities (Eaton) .

Main Components

LV switchgear assemblies generally include:

- Circuit breakers (air, molded case, or miniature) for interrupting fault currents.
- Fuses for overcurrent protection.
- Isolators and disconnect switches to safely isolate circuits.
- Busbars to distribute power internally.
- Cable compartments for terminating line and load cables, often with hinged doors or removable covers for access (Eaton) .
