Routing Best Practices

- Plan the layout: Determine cable paths, sections, and positions before installation to avoid congestion and ensure future maintenance .
- Separate signal and power cables: Keep optical or network pigtails away from power cables to reduce interference .
- Use proper bend radius: Turn cables smoothly at bends, maintaining a minimum bend radius of at least three times the cable diameter to prevent signal loss or fiber breakage .
- Utilize cable trays or ducts: Route cables through trays, ducts, or interlayer spaces in equipment rooms. For top-of-cabinet exits, install a cable tray above the cabinet .
- Centralize ODF racks: Position Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs) centrally in the room to allow pigtails to reach all equipment efficiently and reduce overlapping or congestion .
