Overview of PON Technology

A Passive Optical Network (PON) is a fiber-optic telecommunications system that uses unpowered optical splitters to distribute signals from a single source to multiple endpoints, reducing the need for active electronics between the central office and end users . A typical PON consists of:

- Optical Line Terminal (OLT): Located at the service provider's central office, it manages data transmission and network control .
- Optical Distribution Network (ODN): Passive splitters and fiber cables that distribute signals downstream and aggregate upstream traffic .
- Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Terminals (ONTs): End-user devices that receive and transmit data . PONs are widely used for fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) and fiber-to-the-premises (FTTP) deployments, providing high-speed internet, voice, and video services .

Evolution to PON 6

PON technology has evolved through multiple generations:

- GPON (G.984): 2.488 Gbps downstream, 1.244 Gbps upstream .
- XG-PON / 10G-PON: 10 Gbps downstream, 2.5 Gbps upstream.
