Common Solutions and Cost Factors

 - Small, compact heaters (e.g., PRH-M units) provide targeted warmth for tight spaces.
 - Larger heaters (e.g., PFH-T units) circulate heat throughout bigger enclosures.
- Costs depend on power rating, size, and brand, typically ranging from \$50 to \$300 per unit for standard industrial models .
- Ventilation and Air Circulation
 - Installing fans or vented panels can reduce humidity buildup.
- Costs vary with fan size, enclosure modifications, and installation complexity, generally \$30 to \$150 for small to medium enclosures.
