Project Scale and Complexity: Longer runs, multiple splices, and armored cables increase costs. For example, a 5,000 ft outdoor armored installation with multiple terminations can cost \$11,000–\$14,500, while a full deployment of 6,500 ft with professional testing may reach \$15,000–\$20,000 .
