Chromatography Principle

Chromatography is a technique used to separate components of a mixture based on their differential interactions with a stationary phase and a mobile phase. Each component moves at a different speed through the stationary phase depending on properties such as size, charge, or affinity, resulting in separation. The separated components can then be analyzed individually, often represented as peaks on a chromatogram with retention times indicating their movement through the system .

Analogy to Optical Cable Terminal Boxes

An optical cable terminal box is designed to organize, protect, and route optical fibers efficiently. Its internal structure includes:

- Optical cable fixing frame: Secures incoming cables.
- Strengthening core fixing clip: Stabilizes the fiber core.
- Fiber splicing tray: Protects spliced fibers and stores excess fiber length.
