

Protection Requirements for Trunk Optical Cables



Summary of Content

Protecting trunk optical cables requires proper installation, environmental safeguards, physical protection, monitoring, and regular maintenance to ensure reliable communication.

Installation and Physical Protection

Trunk optical cables should be installed according to manufacturer specifications and industry standards to prevent internal fiber damage. Avoid excessive bending, twisting, or stretching during installation, and use cable management systems such as racks, trays, or conduits to organize and secure the cables (). In high-risk areas, armored or sheathed cables provide additional protection against mechanical stress, rodents, or accidental impact (). Padding or cushioning should be applied where cables pass through sharp edges or openings to prevent wear and tear.

Environmental Protection

Outdoor trunk cables face threats from UV exposure, temperature extremes, moisture, flooding, wind, ice, and soil movement. Installing cables in areas free from excessive moisture, dust, and corrosive chemicals is essential. Direct-burial cables should be placed at appropriate depths and protected with conduits or protective sheaths to prevent damage from soil shifting or accidental digging (). For aerial installations, tension and sagging must be managed to withstand wind and ice loads.
