They serve as the regional backbone of telecommunications networks, supporting internet, telephone, and data transmission over large areas. Unlike local fiber networks, which connect individual homes or businesses, provincial-level cables handle high traffic volumes and provide redundancy for critical services .

Technical Characteristics

- **Fiber Type:** These networks typically use single-mode fibers, which have a small core (~9 microns) and allow long-distance, high-speed data transmission with minimal signal loss . Multi-mode fibers may be used for shorter regional links.
- **Construction:** The fiber core is surrounded by cladding, protective coatings, and strengthening layers (e.g., Kevlar or gel-filled sleeves) to ensure durability in outdoor or harsh environments .
- **Capacity:** Provincial-level cables often carry hundreds of gigabits to terabits per second, supporting multiple service providers and high-demand applications.
- **Redundancy and Routing:** These networks are designed with diverse routes to maintain connectivity during outages or natural disasters, often including underground or tunnel crossings .
