Overview

A single QSFP module can move 100 gigabits per second through a port barely larger than a thumbnail. In hyperscale data centers, that same form factor now scales to 400G and 800G, feeding the east-west traffic demands of AI training clusters and cloud fabrics. The first-generation QSFP supported 4-channel transmission, with each channel typically operating at 10 Gbps, primarily used for data center interconnects and server-to-server links. Its birth marked the dawn of a new era in high-speed data transmission. QSFP Series The QSFP series was developed. The original QSFP+ module supports 4 lanes of 10 Gbps transmission for a total aggregate bandwidth of 40 Gbps. As data traffic continues.
