

Regulations for the Protection of Communication Optical Cables



Summary of Content

Optical cables in communication systems are regulated through a combination of international standards, national electrical codes, and EU directives to ensure safety, reliability, and resilience.

European Union Regulations

In the EU, optical fibre cables must comply with CE marking requirements under the Construction Products Regulation (CPR), which ensures that cables meet essential performance characteristics such as fire reaction and safety for building installations . Submarine and terrestrial optical cables are also subject to EU Action Plans on Cable Security, which outline measures to prevent, detect, respond, and repair damage to critical infrastructure, enhancing resilience against physical and cyber threats . Specific EU regulations, such as Regulation (EU) 2022/869 and the Commission Recommendation on Secure and Resilient Submarine Cable Infrastructures, define standards for Projects of Common and Mutual Interest (PCIs) and funding for secure cable deployment .
