Drop cables are smaller in diameter and lightweight to facilitate easy routing through tight spaces and indoor environments .
- **Flexibility and Bend Resistance:** Drop cables use bend-insensitive fibers (G.657 standard), allowing them to navigate sharp corners and tight conduits without signal loss. Standard fiber optic cables, such as G.652.D, are less tolerant to tight bends and are more suited for long-distance backbone transmission .
