Common Buttons and Their Functions

Start Button: Initiates the operation of the relay or associated equipment, allowing the system to begin normal operation. In safety monitoring relays, pressing Start enables outputs and prepares the system for operation .

Stop Button: Stops the operation of the connected equipment or initiates a controlled shutdown. It is used for normal production stops or emergency halts, depending on the system design .

Reset Button: Resets the relay after a fault or emergency stop. For example, in the MSR5T safety relay, pressing Reset after an E-stop clears the fault condition and re-enables the outputs .

Test Button: Some relays include a test button to simulate fault conditions, allowing operators to verify that the relay and trip circuits function correctly without causing actual system interruptions .

Push-to-Talk or Communication Buttons: In certain relay devices with communication features, buttons like "Talk" or "Relay Assistant" allow operators to interact with other devices or channels, though these are more common in specialized relay communication systems .
