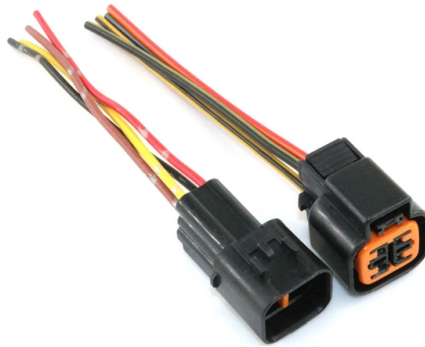


Relay protection for high-pressure fire pumps

Key Components of Relay Protection

Intake Pressure Relief Valves: These valves are critical in relay pumping operations to prevent damage when incoming water pressure exceeds the pump's rated capacity. They can be integral to the pump manifold or added as screw-on devices. When the incoming pressure surpasses a preset level, the valve activates, releasing excess water or pressure to protect the pump. Most are set within 10 psi of the static pressure of the water supply or slightly above, and often include bleeder valves to remove trapped air .

Discharge Pressure Relief Valves: High-pressure fire pumps, especially in high-rise applications, may require discharge relief valves to prevent system components from exceeding their pressure ratings. For example, the OCV 108-2HP-FP valve automatically relieves excess discharge pressure, ensuring the fire system operates safely even when relief set points are higher than standard UL/FM approved valves .

Motor and Pump Protection Relays: Thermistor and temperature relays, such as PTC relays, protect pump motors from overheating, extending service life. Direction-of-rotation relays ensure pumps operate correctly, and level relays prevent dry running, which is particularly important in high-pressure relay setups .
