Directional relay protection detects the direction of fault currents to ensure selective isolation of faulty sections in a power system.

Overview of Directional Protection

Directional relays are designed to operate only when a fault occurs in a specific direction relative to the relay location. Unlike non-directional relays, which respond solely to the magnitude of current or voltage, directional relays use a polarizing quantity (voltage or current) to determine the direction of power flow and decide whether to trip a circuit breaker ().

Types of Directional Relay Protection

- Forward and Reverse Directional Protection
- Forward Direction: The relay operates when the fault current flows in the intended or forward direction from the relay location.
- Reverse Direction: The relay operates when the fault current flows opposite to the intended direction, often used for backup protection in interconnected systems ().
- Directional Overcurrent Relays
- These relays combine overcurrent detection with directional sensing.
- They operate only if the current exceeds a set threshold and flows in the specified direction.
- Commonly used in parallel feeders or ring networks to isolate the faulty line without affecting healthy lines ().
