

Remote access to LAN switch

You can remotely access a network switch on a LAN using Telnet, SSH, or a web interface, with SSH being the most secure method.

Methods for Remote Access

1. SSH (Secure Shell) SSH is the preferred method for secure remote access to a switch. It encrypts all traffic, including login credentials, preventing eavesdropping. To use SSH:

- Ensure the switch has an IP address assigned and SSH service enabled.
- Connect your PC to the same LAN.
- Use an SSH client (e.g., PuTTY, SecureCRT) and enter the switch's IP address.
- Log in with your administrator credentials to access the CLI for configuration and monitoring . 2. Telnet Telnet allows remote command-line access but is not secure, as it transmits credentials in plain text. Steps include:
 - Assign an IP address to the switch and enable Telnet.
 - Connect via a Telnet client using the switch's IP.
 - Enter the username and password to access the CLI . 3. Web Interface (GUI) Many switches provide a web-based interface for easier management:
 - Ensure the switch has an IP address and HTTP/HTTPS service enabled.
 - Open a web browser on a PC connected to the LAN.
 - Enter the switch's IP address in the browser.
