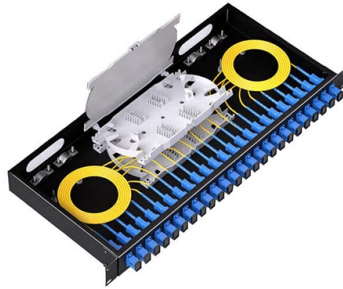


Remove the blockage from the primary distribution box

To remove a blockage from a septic distribution box, manually clear debris and sludge from the box and outlet pipes while following safety precautions.

Identifying the Problem

Signs of a clogged D-box include slow-draining toilets or sinks, pooling water or wet spots in the yard, unusually green grass patches over the drain field, and gurgling sounds in plumbing. Confirm the D-box is the source by locating the buried access lid, typically 12–24 inches below the surface and downhill from the septic tank, and inspecting for sludge, debris, or bio-mat accumulation .

Safety Precautions

- Wear heavy-duty, fluid-resistant gloves and protective eyewear.
- Temporarily halt all water usage in the house to lower the water level in the system .

Clearing the Blockage

- Open the D-box lid carefully and inspect the interior.
- Manually remove sludge, solids, and debris using a small trowel or scoop.
- Check the inlet and outlet pipes for blockages.
