Summary of Content

Repeated grounding in a secondary distribution box ensures safety by connecting the neutral and all metal parts to earth at multiple points, providing a low-impedance path for fault currents.

Purpose of Repeated Grounding

Repeated grounding is used in systems where the neutral point is directly grounded. It involves connecting the grounding device at multiple points along the neutral main line and the distribution box enclosure. This ensures:

- Personnel safety by preventing electric shock from exposed metal parts.
- Equipment protection by providing a low-resistance path for fault currents, allowing overcurrent devices to trip quickly.
- Voltage stabilization during transient conditions or lightning strikes .

Implementation in a Secondary Distribution Box

- **Neutral and Ground Separation:** In a sub-panel or secondary distribution box, the neutral conductor must not be bonded to the ground bus downstream of the main service panel. The main panel is the only point where neutral and ground are connected .
