Why Jumper Wires Are Problematic

Jumper wires in distribution boxes are often used to connect multiple circuit breakers from a single terminal. This method is explicitly prohibited by national standards because it can create serious safety hazards. The first wire from the main switch carries the sum of currents from all downstream breakers, and subsequent jumpers carry progressively high currents, which can overload wires without tripping the breakers, leading to potential fire risks .

Correct Method: Using Bolts or Parallel Groove Connectors

Instead of jumpers, the proper approach is to:

- Run individual wires from the main switch to each circuit breaker, ensuring each wire carries only the current for its own circuit .
- Use single-bolt parallel groove connectors with heat shrink sleeves to join multiple wires safely if space constraints exist .
- Maintain adequate spacing inside the distribution box to allow for heat dissipation and prevent crowding . This method ensures that each branch is protected by its own breaker, reducing the risk of overload and improving overall safety.
