

Requirement for distribution boxes to have their own grounding wire



Summary of Content

Metal distribution boxes must be properly grounded, often requiring a dedicated grounding conductor to ensure safety and NEC compliance.

NEC Requirements and Rationale

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC) 250.148, all metallic boxes, including distribution boxes, must maintain continuity of equipment grounding conductors. This ensures that if a fault occurs, such as a loose wire contacting the metal box, the fault current has a low-resistance path to trip the breaker, preventing electric shock or fire hazards. The NEC specifies that:

- Metal boxes must be bonded to the equipment grounding conductor using a dedicated grounding screw or clip.
- All equipment grounding conductors within the box must be connected together to maintain continuity, even if devices are removed or replaced.
- Metal doors of distribution boxes also require bonding to prevent static discharge or accidental shock if the door becomes energized. For non-metallic boxes, a separate grounding conductor is generally not required unless metallic components (like frames or hinges) are present.

Practical Installation Considerations

- Use a dedicated green grounding screw or clip to bond the metal box and door; do not rely on mounting bolts alone.
