

Requirements for Drilling Holes to Install Cable Trays

Drilling holes for cable tray installation requires precise placement, correct sizing, adherence to fire safety regulations, and proper alignment with support systems.

Hole Placement and Templates

When installing cable trays, holes must be accurately located to align with splice plates, support brackets, or tray hangers. The most common method is to use a splice plate or pre-punched template as a guide, clamping it to the tray or support rail and drilling through the marked positions. Drill jigs or short side rails with factory hole patterns can also serve as stops to ensure consistent hole placement .

Hole Size and Hardware Compatibility

The drill size should match the hardware supplied with the cable tray system, such as bolts, rivets, or tek screws. For example, field-drilled holes in solid-bottom trays are often 7/16" from the inside edge for center hangers, while dropout brackets may require 5/16" holes . After drilling, remove burrs to prevent damage to cables and ensure proper fit of fasteners.

Structural and Safety Considerations

- Avoid cutting structural members; holes should only be drilled in areas that do not compromise building integrity .
- Maintain minimum clearance around trays (typically 12" above and to the side) for accessibility and cable routing .
