

Requirements for Grounding Grid of Distribution Box



Overview

Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. Grounding of the units: If you're working with electrical systems, you know that grounding isn't just some bureaucratic requirement—it's literally the difference between a safe, functional system and a potential disaster. This helps to reduce the potential difference that exists between conductive parts and the earth. Protective grounds must be installed so all phases of lines or cable are visibly and effectively bonded together in a multi-phase. Correct grounding of services depends upon understanding the definition and role of the grounded conductor. The neutral conductor is typically the grounded conductor connected to the system's neutral point, carrying current under normal operation.
