Level 3 distribution boxes serve as the final junction point for electrical appliances on construction sites, requiring proper installation, grounding, and safety protection to ensure compliance and operational safety.

Role and Function

Level 3 distribution boxes are the final junction boxes in a three-level electrical distribution system on construction sites. They are installed under the main distribution and secondary boxes and can be either movable or fixed. Each Level 3 box connects directly to the leakage protection switch, ensuring that each electrical appliance has dedicated protection. This setup follows the principle of “one machine, one switch, one leakage, one box, one lock”, preventing multiple devices from being controlled by the same switch and enhancing safety .

Installation Requirements

Site Selection:

- Install the box close to the power supply to minimize power loss and ensure safety.
- Avoid humid, corrosive, or poorly ventilated areas to prevent overheating and equipment damage .

Height and Fixing:

- The bottom edge of the box should be 1.5–1.8 meters above the ground for convenient operation and inspection.
