

Requirements for cable tray access



Summary of Content

Cable trays must have a minimum of 12 inches of vertical clearance above them to allow safe installation and maintenance, according to the 2026 NEC.

Minimum Clearance

The 2026 National Electrical Code (NEC) Section 392.18(F) specifies that at least 12 inches of access space above cable trays must be maintained to permit installation and maintenance of cables. This update replaces the previous subjective requirement of “adequate access,” providing a clear, measurable standard that aligns with ANSI/TIA/EIA-569-A for telecommunications pathways.

Exceptions

There are several exceptions where reduced clearance is allowed:

- IT equipment rooms: Controlled environments may allow less than 12 inches if compliant with NEC 645.5.
- Industrial establishments: Smaller clearances are permitted if only qualified personnel perform maintenance.
- Special permission: The authority having jurisdiction (AHJ) can authorize reduced space.
- Equipment crossings: Temporary encroachment by equipment above the tray is acceptable without violating the rule.
