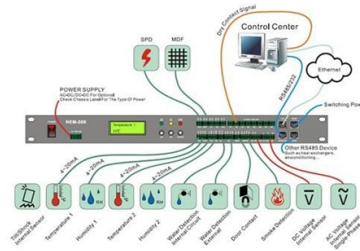


Requirements for installing electrical distribution boxes in masonry walls
