

Requirements for marking electrical distribution boxes



Summary of Content

Electrical distribution boxes must be clearly labeled with circuit identification, electrical ratings, safety warnings, and compliance information to ensure safe operation and maintenance.

Key Markings

1. **Electrical Ratings:** Distribution boxes should display the voltage, current, and phase information of the system. This helps confirm compatibility with connected equipment and prevents circuit overloads or failures (UL 969, ANSI/UL standards) .
2. **Circuit Identification:** Each breaker or fuse should be labeled to indicate the specific circuit it controls, such as lighting, outlets, or machinery. Labels should be concise, legible, and correspond to a circuit directory or one-line diagram for easy reference .
3. **Safety Warnings and Hazard Notices:** Labels must include warnings about electric shock, arc flash, or other hazards. For industrial panels, arc flash labels indicate PPE requirements and approach restrictions. Safety symbols or pictographs are often used for quick recognition .
4. **Compliance and Regulatory Information:** Markings should indicate compliance with local and national standards, such as OSHA 29 CFR 1910.145, ANSI, NEC, or CSA standards. This ensures the installation meets legal and safety requirements .
5. **Special Equipment Indicators:** If the panel contains Surge Protection Devices (SPDs), RCDs, or other specialized equipment, their presence must be clearly marked near the distribution box for maintenance and inspection purposes .
