Required Equipment

To connect your router to a fiber optic port, you will need:

- Power adapters: For both the ONT and router.

- Install the ONT

- Connect the fiber optic cable to the ONT's optical port, handling the connector carefully to avoid dirt or damage .
- Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, which may take a few minutes.
