SDH Aggregation

Synchronous Digital Hierarchy (SDH) is a standardized protocol for transmitting large volumes of data over optical fiber. SDH aggregation involves multiplexing lower-rate signals (like E1 or STM-1) into higher-rate streams (STM-4, STM-16), allowing efficient transport of both TDM and packet-based traffic. Devices like the STM-1/4 SDH Multiplexer and GigE-SDH Aggregator can handle multiple services simultaneously, including Ethernet, E1, and optical interfaces, while providing time-slot cross-connection and IP data switching. This enables SDH networks to consolidate traffic from multiple sources and deliver it to core networks efficiently. Key features of SDH aggregation include:

- Flexible traffic engineering with add/drop and hairpin applications
- Support for multiple network topologies with self-healing mechanisms
- Integration of packet and TDM traffic for enterprise or carrier networks

Switch Connection Aggregation

Switch aggregation, also called link aggregation or trunking, is a method to combine multiple network links between switches or routers into a single logical interface. This technique is widely used in Ethernet networks to:

- Increase bandwidth by combining multiple physical links
