Use OSHA-compliant “Temporary Power Connected – Do Not Disconnect” tags or signs to clearly indicate energized temporary power distribution boxes.

Key Requirements

OSHA and NFPA Compliance: Temporary power distribution boxes must be marked appropriately to meet OSHA standards [1910.303(e) and 1926.405(g)(2)(iv)] and NFPA 70E requirements. Permanent outlet boxes or standard wall plates are not acceptable for temporary power applications . Sign Wording: Commonly used signage includes phrases such as:

- “Temporary Power Connected – Do Not Disconnect”
 - “Caution: Temporary Power – Authorized Personnel Only”
 - “Danger: High Voltage – Temporary Power” These messages alert workers that the box is energized and should not be tampered with .
- Materials and Durability: Signs should be made from durable, weather-resistant materials suitable for indoor and outdoor use:
- Plastic tags: High-strength, chemical- and weather-resistant, ideal for rough environments.
 - Laminated tags: Tear-proof, waterproof, and resistant to dirt, grease, and liquid splashes.
