

Sealing off outdoor electrical distribution boxes

Key Steps for Sealing

1. Turn Off Power and Ensure Safety Before any work, switch off the circuit at the main panel and verify with a voltage tester. - For larger voids, minimal-expansion, fire-rated foam can fill gaps without distorting the box .
- Leave the bottom uncaulked if the cover design allows drainage, preventing water accumulation . 4. Protect Connections Inside the Box
- Use waterproof wire connectors and insulate all connections with weather-resistant materials
