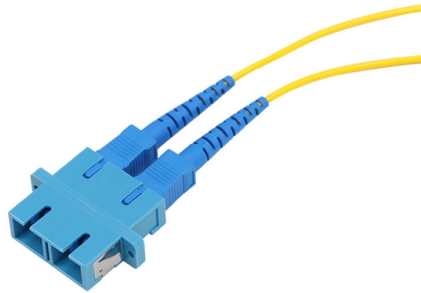


Sealing the wiring ports in the distribution box

- **Non-Hardening Electrical Putty:** Moldable putty (duct seal or mastic) can be applied around wire bundles inside the box to block air, moisture, and pests while remaining flexible for future adjustments.
- **Silicone or Polyurethane Caulk:** Apply around the perimeter of the box and at wire entry points for outdoor enclosures. For vertical installations, caulk the top and sides, leaving the bottom unsealed to allow drainage.
- **Spray Foam:** Minimal-expansion, fire-rated foam can fill larger voids around the box or deep wall penetrations, providing insulation and fire protection.
