

Sequence of Identification Signs for Construction Site Electrical Distribution Boxes



Summary of Content

Electrical distribution boxes on construction sites should be clearly labeled with system voltage, circuit identity, and color-coded markings according to standardized guidelines.

Lettering and Graphics

- Use consistent names, abbreviations, and colors that match the designations in the project submittals and applicable codes .
- Apply engraved plastic-laminate labels or pressure-sensitive self-adhesive labels on the outside of box covers for major electrical equipment .
- For concealed boxes, use indelible markers (black or red) to indicate system and circuit information .

Color Coding

- Conduits and raceways should be color-banded to indicate system type. Bands must be 2 inches wide, fully encircling the conduit, and placed at changes in direction, wall/floor penetrations, and every 40 feet along straight runs .
- Typical color codes include:
- Telecommunications: Green and Yellow with Blue and White cables
- Fire Alarm Systems: Red
