

Should cable trays be used for vertical sections of electrical wires



Overview

The 2026 NEC introduced an important update: cable trays must have at least 12 inches of clear vertical space above them to allow for installation and maintenance access. This document, based on national standards such as GB 50303 "Code for Acceptance of. NEC Article 392 defines cable tray as "a unit or assembly of units or sections and associated fittings forming a structural system used to securely fasten or support cables and raceways. " Cable tray itself is not classified as a raceway under the NEC, except when used as specified in specific.
