Cable Construction and Considerations

Single-core cables consist of a central conductor, usually copper or aluminum, surrounded by insulation and sometimes a metallic sheath or armor for mechanical protection and environmental resistance. When multiple single-core cables are used per phase, imbalances in current distribution can occur if the physical arrangement is not optimized, even if the total phase current is balanced. This can lead to overheating and reduced cable lifespan.

Common Formations

Trefoil Formation:

- Cables are arranged in a triangular pattern, keeping each phase equidistant.
- Reduces circulating currents and magnetic field imbalances.
- Commonly used for low and medium voltage applications up to 132 kV.
- Space-efficient but may reduce heat dissipation due to cable contact.

Flat Formation:

- Cables are laid side by side in a single row.
- Easier to install and allows better heat dissipation for the middle phase.
