Single-mode fiber (SMF) has a very narrow core, typically around 8-10 micrometers, allowing only one light mode to propagate, usually from a laser source. Multimode fiber (MMF), in contrast, has a larger core (50-62.5 micrometers) that supports multiple light modes, often using LEDs or VCSELs. Because of this difference, injecting multimode light into a single-mode fiber is inefficient: most of the light will not couple into the narrow core, leading to significant signal loss and reduced performance.

Practical Implications

While it is technically possible to connect a multimode transceiver to a single-mode fiber, the following issues arise:

- **Signal Loss:** The mismatch between the large multimode light cone and the small single-mode core causes high insertion loss.
- **Distance Limitations:** Single-mode fiber is optimized for long-distance transmission with minimal dispersion, but multimode signals may experience modal dispersion if forced into SMF, reducing effective distance.
