

Spacing between cable trays and various pipes



Overview

When cable trays intersect below pipelines carrying corrosive liquids or above pipelines carrying corrosive gases, the distance should not be less than 500 mm. Additionally, at the intersection, the cable tray should be protected with a corrosion-resistant cover. Cable trays and pipes serve as the backbone of electrical and fluid transportation systems in both residential and industrial environments. Cable trays and pipes work together to manage the flow of electricity, fluids, and gases, with cable trays primarily supporting electrical cables, and pipes. The safety of your people and the reliability of your electrical system depend on proper cable tray support spacing. multiconductor cable, support spacing, grounding/bonding as an equipment grounding conductor, and power/low-voltage separation. Many installation problems such as excessive tray deflection, vibration, connector failure, and uneven load distribution occur because support spacing was.
