

Spacing between left and right sides of the cable tray

The minimum horizontal spacing between parallel cable trays should generally be at least 0.6 meters, with reduced spacing allowed if trays are shielded.

Horizontal Spacing Guidelines

When installing two cable trays side by side at the same height, the minimum distance between them should be 0.6 meters. This spacing ensures adequate maintenance access, inspection, and airflow for heat dissipation, while also reducing the risk of cables touching, which could lead to short circuits or interference (Apex Tray) . For power and signal cable trays, horizontal separation is critical to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI). The recommended minimum distance is 0.5 meters, but if the trays are shielded, this can be reduced to 0.3 meters without compromising signal integrity (Apex Tray) . Industry standards also suggest 12 inches (300 mm) as a practical minimum horizontal spacing between power and instrumentation trays to maintain signal quality (Zero Instrument) .

Vertical and Structural Considerations
