- High Resistance (HR) Alloys: ZnAl, ZnMg, and ZnNi coatings offer improved corrosion protection with thinner, more uniform layers suitable for wiremesh trays and fasteners .
- Zinc-Rich Coatings: Applied by spraying or centrifuging at lower temperatures, these coatings protect steel while avoiding deformation of thin elements .
